### 2. ENTRY DEADLINE

**5pm FRIDAY**  
**24th February 2012**

No late entries accepted

### 3. SIZE CONSIDERATIONS

Gallery Central is the venue for the exhibition and has sizeable display space. Due to this space each artist is required to enter a minimum of 3 pieces and a maximum of 8 pieces per artist. Due to the exhibition being a group show size restrictions may apply. Contact the exhibition Coordinator to discuss any concerns.

### 4. ORIGINALITY

All art work must be recent, made to address the theme for the exhibition

#### “Wearable Narratives”

The works must be the original work of the artist completed in the last 12 months and not previously exhibited.

### 5. WORKS FOR SALE ONLY

All work must be for sale, the price must include 30% commission and GST. Artists will receive payment, less commission for any works sold by Gallery Central within 30 days of closure of the exhibition.

### 6. PAYMENTS

If you have an ABN please provide us with these details on the entry form provided. Sale price must include a 30% commission and include GST. If you do not have an ABN you will be required to provide a “Statement by a Supplier” form.

### 7. JUDGING & AWARDS

JMGA WA reserves the right to exclude from the exhibition any submitted items that they deem inappropriate, of insufficient merit or that arrived in damaged condition. ### 7. DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

Works are to be delivered to Gallery Central, Aberdeen St Northbridge during the hours of 12pm—5pm on Tuesday 5th June. Unsold works can be collected on Monday 2nd July 2pm—5pm from the gallery.

### 8. COPYRIGHT

The artists agree to the reproduction in whole or in part by print or electronic media only for promotion of the exhibition. Copyright remains the property of the artist.

### 9. STUDENT ENTRIES

All student entries must be accompanied with a signed authorisation from a current lecturer as well as the institute the student is currently studying at (please see entry form). The Students category is only open to under gradu-

### 10. INSURANCE

Insurance cover is provided for artworks whilst in the care and custody of the Central Gallery. The onus is on the Exhibitor to provide proof of value in an insurance claim.

### 11. ARTIST STATEMENT

An artist statement limit 1 page is required, this is not a C.V it is a statement about the journey/ concept development behind your work. This is to be delivered on the same day as you work to the Gallery.

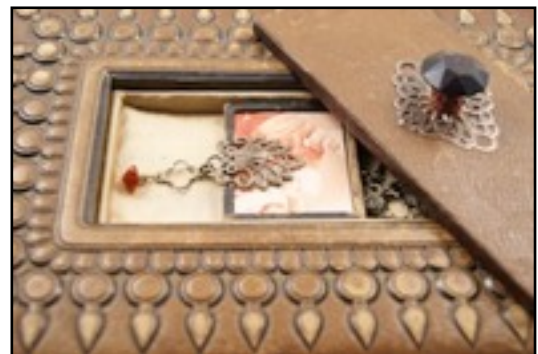
