I have recently opened a studio/retail/ teaching space in Newcastle that is going very well and we need some help to satisfy the local demand for contemporary jewellery. I have drafted a simple paragraph outlining this request and providing details of our website to enable people to learn more and contact us.

Studio Melt was opened in the centre of Newcastle earlier this year by contemporary jewellers Angela Hailey and Suzy Manning, with the assistance of the fabulous renew Newcastle program. Our studio is set up to provide us a place to make jewellery, but is also a store front and teaching space. Newcastle has been overwhelmingly supportive of our practice and it has become abundantly clear that there is an appetite for contemporary jewellery that we just can't satisfy on our own. So, we are signing a lease to stay put and putting a call out to other contemporary jewellers and object makers to submit their work for consideration.
