The Gallery's collection of contemporary Australian jewellery is being exhibited in its glorious entirety, for the very first time.

The Rhianon Vernon-Roberts Memorial Collection, established in late 1991, consists of more than one hundred items of jewellery by fifty-five innovative contemporary jewellers, making it one of the most important collections of its type in Australia. The collection promotes one-off, experimental studio jewellery developed for exhibition. From precious materials to found forms, the jewellery in the exhibition highlights the capacity of artists to push material and conceptual boundaries.

The Rhianon Vernon-Roberts Memorial Collection was established and is actively supported by Dr. Jane and Prof. Barrie Vernon-Roberts AO in memory of their daughter and talented jeweller, Rhianon (1964-1990).

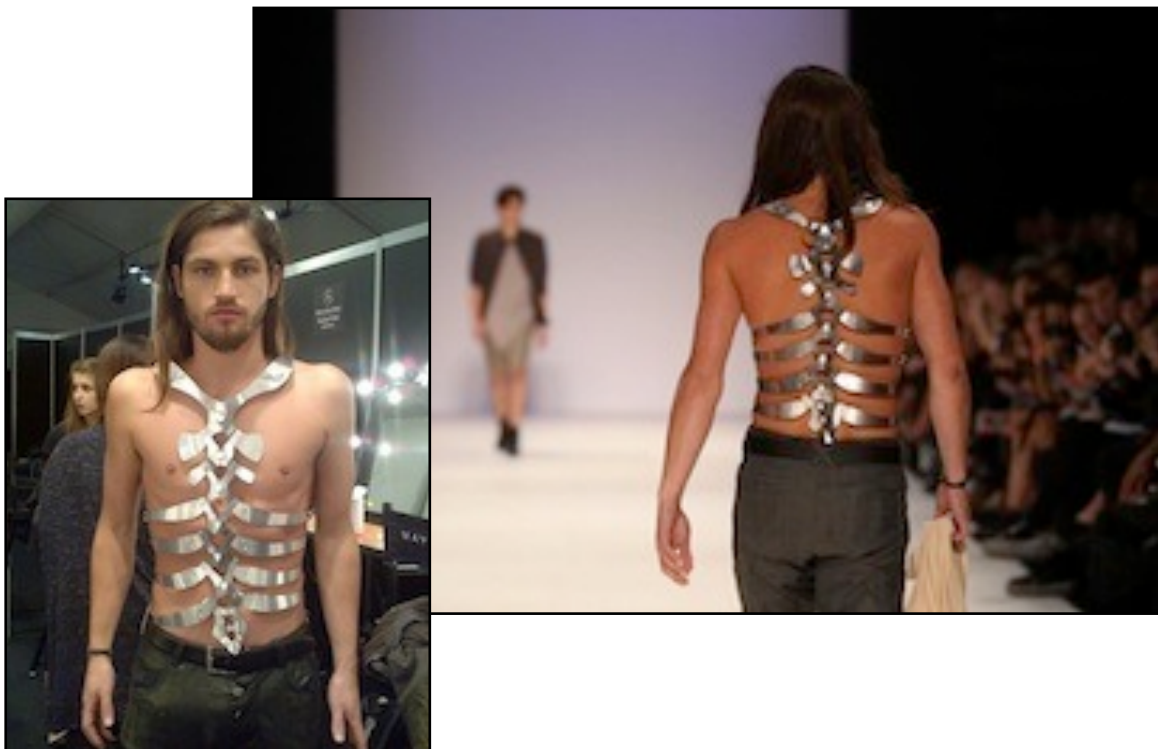

Will keep you all posted as things develop. As you can imagine with 18 days before I leave, I am rather busy getting all those last minutes arrangements done.

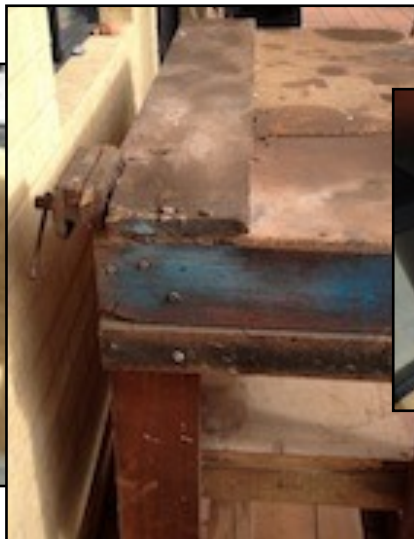

Minutes from previous meeting on 28th March moved as accepted with amendments that treasurers report for AGM was presented at tonight's meeting– Gloria Slinger, seconded Max Butcher.

Business arising: Julie-Ann purchased a lockable box to store the JMGA library books which will stay at Alexander Park Craft House. There is still some interest in going to Riccardo's studio for one meeting to determine its suitability for monthly meetings.

Plinth storage is paid up till July. Helen Heap has volunteered to investigate the condition and types of plinths and display cabinets required for the JMGA member's exhibition.

Members are encouraged to put their name forward to help during the exhibition and to participate in member floor talks.

Correspondence in: The Craft House members invited to choose a representative to attend a meeting with all other representative members. Max Butcher has volunteered to attend the meeting.

General Business.

NOTE: The 2 year treasurers report, not tabled at the AGM, was presented and moved by Jeff Palfreyman and seconded by Marc Synnot.

The treasurer opened for discussion the best thing to do with the JMGA Bankwest Account 2. It was unanimously decided to keep \$5,000 in the conference account and the rest in a 7 month term deposit. Moved by Gloria Slinger and seconded by Jill Parnell.

Exhibition business: Julie-Ann suggested JMGA sponsor an award. Max Butcher moved that JMGA agree in principal to sponsor an award up to the value of \$500 and that the exhibition committee decide upon the details of the award. Motion seconded by Marc Synnot and all present members unanimously agreed.

The judges for the exhibition are David Forrest from Gallery East and Sarah Elson.

The exhibition committee are still seeking a wine sponsor.

Helen Head is following up on condition and whereabouts of plinths and display cabinets.

JMGA logo: The logo had been narrowed down to 2 and the members present unanimously agreed on the first option with the solid A. This is to be further refined in respect to the inclusion or not of the words, size and placement of Jewellers and Metalsmiths Group WA incorporated. Julie-Ann will continue liaising with the designer.
