Exhibitions

What Goes Around: an exhibition of contemporary Western Australian jewellery and objects

More than 100 works by 44 members will be on display at the 12th biennial award exhibition for JMGA WA Inc members. **The exhibition will be held at Turner Galleries, Engine Room 1 from November 25 to December 17, 2016.** Works span a variety of subject matter, all pertaining to and reflecting on the exhibition theme of "What Goes Around".

The exhibition will open on Friday 25 November from 6-8pm. Turner Galleries will have 3 exhibitions opening at the same time, as such there wont be any speeches or awards presented on that evening, just drinks and nibbles. Awards will be presented the following day at the start of the Artist Talk session.

Artist Talks

Three JMGA WA members - Sultana Shamshi, Katrina Virgona and Marcus Synnot – have agreed to provide a short artist talk on Saturday 26 November at 3pm. Please come along to support your fellow members and hear a little about their work.

Awards

Prizes will be awarded to artists for their work in three categories: Technical Excellence; Best Interpretation of the Theme; and Outstanding Student Work. Judging will be undertaken by jeweller and silversmith Philip Noakes (recently appointed as Fellow of the Institute of Professional Goldsmiths, London), and Dr Dorothy Erickson (internationally exhibiting artist jeweller, historian and author).

A People's Choice Award will provide an opportunity for visitors to vote for their favourite work. The winning artwork of the People's Choice Award will be announced on Monday December 19.
