Dorothy won the Peter Walker Fine Art Writing Award for work published in 2011. It was a piece on the woodcarver William Howitt.

A Bit about the Summerset Arts Festival

JMGA WA members are invited to exhibit and sell during the **Summerset Arts Festival 2013**, an array of unique, hand-crafted contemporary jewellery and objects. The work will be professionally presented, unique and handcrafted to a high standard.

As part of the exhibition we will include Artist talks on some of the techniques used to create the work ie. enameling, casting and jewellery making techniques in general. The theme for the exhibition will relate to the Summerset Arts Festival: Fiestas, sun, sea, surf, cultural diversity and lifestyle in City of Stirling.

All the works on display will be for sale and available for collection at the end of the exhibition. The event will take place early February 2013.

COS Festival Information

The City of Stirling Summerset Art Festival will be held over three weeks in February 2013, and will feature dance, theatre, live music, art exhibitions, workshops and more. Each year the Festival attracts over 30,000 people to a range of events that celebrate the City's lifestyle and diversity. Our exhibition will be advertised in the booklet of events that is distributed to all residents in the City of Stirling.

This is a great opportunity for JMGA WA members to be a part of the Summerset Arts Festival and to promote their work.

Myself and Phillip Noakes are embarking on a new venture, of opening a jewellery studio/ workshop/ school. We will be offering benches for rent, casual spaces and more long term rentals; along with classes and workshops: with access to a fully equipped jewellery workshop space with a lecturer to assist in design development and problem solving. We are developing a space with a library, a small gallery space, information on and about contemporary jewellery and design, talks and workshops from other contemporary jewellers and classes. We are currently seeking expressions of interest from anyone looking to be an initial tenant, prepared to commit to a 6 month lease, with access to a fully equipped workshop for approx \$100 a week.
