Meeting started 8.19pm

Correspondence In: Emails which have been forwarded on to members previously; Invitation presented by Felicity Peters to a workshop "Woodside Better Business: Getting Structured." Details to follow in email to members.

### **Business arising from previous minutes:**

1. Jane Walker's address to be forwarded to H Heap by email
2. Queensland exhibition. Expenses becoming more clear. Rent of gallery: \$1400 ( this is a share of the cost as other groups will be sharing the space). Catalogue: \$3000. These expenses have been approved for payment by the executive.
3. Payment of Queensland exhibition expenses will require money to be withdrawn from the Westpac Gold Term Deposit in which there is \$14, 315.13 and which matures on July 22 2013. The process for this was outlined by the Treasurer,



Gloria Slinger. A letter is needed from the President on behalf of JMGA WA Inc, stating that the membership has approved the withdrawal of funds from this account. The minutes of the meeting stating that this approval has been granted should accompany the letter. These documents will give Gloria the authority to proceed.

Therefore, Felicity Peters moved :

That \$5000 be released from the Bankwest Gold Term Deposit, Account number 089-308178-4, and deposited into Cheque Account Number 417-071-9A at Bankwest for the purpose of paying expenses incurred for the Queensland exhibition, Convergence.

Motion Carried by vote of members.

4. Update on Stefano Marchetti workshop: Felicity Peters has received an airfare quote for Stefano of \$3000. She is hoping to arrange for this to be shared with JMGA Brisbane and Melbourne as they are also interested in workshops by Stefano. The use of Contemporary Metal's premises for the workshop is in negotiation. The cost there will be \$750. The workshop will run from Jan 7-11 2014. It will likely cost \$450 per person. There will be a limit of 10 participants. Question raised of JMGA WA funding some of the cost of the workshop. Felicity will also approach the Italian Consulate to gauge their interest in funding too. Felicity circulated photographs of work which could be done under Stefano's tuition. Thanks to Felicity for her hard work.
5. Felicity urged members to begin to think about future workshops in which they would be interested, which JMGA WA could support, as a way of furthering contemporary jewellery in Perth.
